Cross the river that gives its name to the Ryedale district for a leisurely spin around a gently undulating and very pleasant part of the Vale of Pickering. Nice perspectives of the North York Moors, Yorkshire Wolds and Howardian Hills, plus several village pubs to stop at. Flamingo Land theme park is at Kirby Misperton and Eden Camp museum is just off the route near Malton.
